



## **“Student Ambassador National Programme” on Child Protection for School Senior Prefects National Child Protection Authority.**

The “**Student Ambassador National Programme**” is a programme organized by National Child Protection Authority which is specially created with the purpose of developing knowledge, skills & attitudes of senior school prefects on child protection. Here, the school prefects from grade 9 and above are considered as senior prefects. It is expected to implement a sustainable programme aimed at school prefects in order to create a child friendly & protective environment within the school.

Child friendly school is a school which actively fulfills each & every right of every child mentioned on the Universal Convention on the Rights of the Children (UNCRC). It is expected to get the active involvement of school prefects through “**Student Ambassador National Programme**” to establish child friendly school concept in schools.

It is a prime concern to build a leader of a child protection who prioritize child protection, stand against child abuse, take actions to protect children in every possible occasion as future adults or professionals occupy in diverse sectors with the exposure they gain during young age as a Student Ambassador.

### **Objectives of this programme :**

1. Create awareness on the National Policy on Child Protection for School Prefects.
2. Get the contribution of school prefects to minimize & to prevent child abuse within schools.
3. Ensure the participation of school prefects for decision making process.
4. Intervene to develop knowledge, skills & attitudes including leadership of prefects to create a child friendly & protective environment.
5. Contribute to build a responsible & accountable prefect community in child protection.

The role of school prefects is crucial when implementing child protection practically. “**Student Ambassador National Programme**” will prepare school prefects to take the leadership to stabilize child protection in schools with the support of prefect board. National Child Protection Authority wishes to make present Sri Lankan children sensitive on child protection & make them responsible citizens with leadership through this programme.

The schools those who wish to participate for this Student Ambassador National Programme need to get the registration at National Child Protection Authority. The registration form can be downloaded from National Child Protection Authority website [www.childprotection.gov.lk](http://www.childprotection.gov.lk) or else can be collected from District Child Protection Officer (DCPO) & District Psychosocial Officers (DPSO) who are employed at District Secretariat and Divisional Child Protection Officers (DivCPO) who are employed at Divisional Secretariat.

## **Student Ambassador National Programme will be conducted in 5 stages**

**Step 01:** Awareness programme for students, prefect in-charge teachers & principals registered for “**Student Ambassador National Programme on Child Protection for Senior School Prefects**”.

**Step 02: Conduct Student Ambassador District Training Programme :** for this training programme prefect in - charge teacher(Male/ Female) & five prefects including head prefect -(male) & head prefect - (female) (If mix school) head prefect - (male) / head prefect - (female) & vice head prefect - (male) & vice head prefect - (female) (if girl’s school / boys’ school) and three from senior prefects board (representing grade 10 & 12) should be participated representing the school. The training will be given on how to conduct Student Ambassador programme & about the 15 activities which should be implemented inside the school.

Coordinating & conducting programs will be done through zoom platform depending on the requirement

**Step 03: Implement Student Ambassador Programme in School**

Conduct 15 activities introduced by National Child Protection Authority in the school. (School prefect board, class monitors, prefect in-charge teacher (male & female) & principal should conduct programme with the guidance of National Child Protection Authority.

**Step 04: Conduct District Student Ambassador Summit**

District & Divisional Officers of National Child Protection Authority will organize the District Summit. The principal & head prefect (male/ female) should participate for this district summit.

**Step 05: Organize Student Ambassador National Summit** by National Child Protection Authority.
