- **BACHELOR OF ARCHITECTURE DEGREE, BACHELOR OF DESIGN DEGREE, BACHELOR OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE DEGREE (FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE)**
- **FASHION DESIGN & PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT DEGREE (FACULTY OF ENGINEERING)**

Applications are hereby invited for the above Aptitude Tests from the candidates who possess the minimum University Admission requirements as specified under Section 1.2 of the Handbook on “Admission to Undergraduate Courses of the Universities in Sri Lanka Academic Year – 2025/2026”, issued by the University Grants Commission.

Applicants who submit applications via internet to the University Grants Commission to be considered for admission to Universities are required, in addition, to apply to sit and pass the Aptitude Tests mentioned herein, if they wish to be considered for admission to the respective courses.

To be eligible to sit for the Aptitude Tests for the Degree Courses mentioned above, candidates are required to possess the qualifications listed below under the respective courses.

**(1) Bachelor of Architecture Degree
(Faculty of Architecture)**

A candidate who sat for the G.C.E (A/L) regarding the year 2025 Examination, should have obtained a “S” Pass in; (see Sections 1.2 and 2.2.8.6 of UGC Handbook 2025/2026)

(i) at least one of the following subjects:

In addition, candidates must fulfill the following requirements;

- **At least an Ordinary Pass (S) in English** at the G.C.E (O/L) Examination.
- **At least a Credit Pass (C) in Mathematics** at the G.C.E (O/L) Examination or an **Ordinary Pass (S) in Mathematics** at the G.C.E (A/L) Examination.

**(2) Bachelor of Design Degree
(Faculty of Architecture)**

A candidate who sat for the G.C.E (A/L) regarding the year 2025 Examination, should have obtained at least “S” Grades in any three subjects at G.C.E (A/L) Examination (See Sections 1.2 and 2.2.8.9 of UGC Handbook 2025/2026).

In addition, candidates must fulfill the following requirements;

- **At least an Ordinary Pass (S) in English** at the G.C.E (O/L) Examination.
- **At least a Credit Pass (C) in Mathematics** at the G.C.E (O/L) Examination or an **Ordinary Pass (S) in Mathematics** at the G.C.E (A/L) Examination.
- **At least a Credit Pass (C) in Science** at the G.C.E (O/L) Examination.

**(3) Bachelor of Landscape Architecture Degree
(Faculty of Architecture)**

A candidate who sat for the G.C.E (A/L) regarding the year 2025 Examination, should have obtained at least a “S” Pass in; (see Sections 1.2 and 2.2.8.8 of UGC Hand Book 2025/2026)

(i) at least one of the following subjects:

- At least a **Credit Pass (C) in Mathematics** at the G.C.E (O/L) Examination or an **Ordinary Pass (S) in Mathematics** at the G.C.E (A/L) Examination.

(4) Fashion Design & Product Development Degree
(Faculty of Engineering)

A candidate who sat for the G.C.E (A/L) regarding the year 2025 Examination should have obtained at least “S” Grades in any three subjects at G.C.E (A/L) Examination. (see **Sections 1.2 and 2.2.8.7 of UGC Hand Book 2025/2026**)

In addition, candidates must fulfill the following requirement;

- At least a **Credit Pass (C) in English, Mathematics and Science** at the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination.

• **SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS:**

Candidates are required to fill and submit the online application form available in the University of Moratuwa Website (<https://uom.lk/>). The payment slip and the certified copies of result sheets should be uploaded online along with the application form.

Scanned copies of G.C.E (O/L) and (A/L) certificates certified by **the principal or a Justice of Peace or an executive grade officer in the government sector** should be uploaded along with the application. The official stamp of the certifying officer should be placed on each certified

copy. If a candidate submits a certificate of G.C.E (A/L) obtained from the Website, the name of the applicant and A/L Index number should be mentioned and certified by the Principal or a justice of peace or an executive grade officer in the government sector.

Examination Fees :

A scanned copy of the pay-in-voucher obtained from any Branch of the Bank of Ceylon drawn in favor of the “Vice-Chancellor, University of Moratuwa” **Account No. 306836 (Katubedda Branch)** should accompany with the application form. **Please clearly indicate the candidate’s NIC number and “Aptitude Test” on the payment slip. Payments can also be made through <https://pay.uom.lk> . The Reference/Pay Advice ID should be entered as APT1500 for one course, APT3000 for two courses, APT4500 for three courses and APT6000 for four courses, when making payments.**

(ATM Payments, Cheques, Postal / Money Orders will not be accepted).

Examination Fee per programme is Rs. 1,500/-

If you wish to apply for more than one programme, paying vouchers should be uploaded as follows;

For one programme	- Rs. 1,500/-
For two programmes	- Rs. 3,000/-
For three programmes	- Rs. 4,500/-
For four programmes	- Rs. 6,000/-

• **SPECIAL NOTES:**

- (i) If any difference exists in the name indicated in the application form and the certificates, candidates should submit a scanned copy of an affidavit to confirm that they relate to one and the same person.
- (ii) Link to download the admission letters will be sent to the individual candidates who have satisfied the admission requirements for each Aptitude Test directly to the e-mail address which the candidate used in registration to submit the application. Therefore, the candidates are requested to use a valid e-mail address for the registration.
- (iii) The payment of disqualified candidates will not be refunded under any circumstance.
- (iv) Applications shall be rejected due to following reasons.
 - (a) Submission of incomplete online applications.
 - (b) Not possessing the minimum admission requirements and other requirements to become eligible to sit for the Aptitude Tests as per above Criteria.
- (v) Candidates who do not currently fulfill the minimum eligibility requirements to be eligible for the university admission due to withholding the results of the GCE (Advanced Level) examination held for the year 2025 or due to applying for re-scrutiny of the results may become eligible for admission for the said courses upon releasing such results and it is essential that such candidates have passed the aptitude test by then. Therefore, such candidates should contact the University of Moratuwa via the e – mail address admissions@uom.lk before 06th May 2026.

- (vi) Pass in Aptitude Test is not the only requirement to be eligible for admission to a degree programme.
- (vii) Any alteration will not be entertained after submission of the application form. Therefore, candidates are requested to verify the accuracy prior to online submission.
