for Sri Lankan Handcrafted Jewellery Designers – Beginners Programme

The High Commission of India in Sri Lanka, in collaboration with the Ministry of Industry and Entrepreneurship Development, is pleased to announce a Capacity Building Training Programme for Sri Lankan Handcrafted Jewellery Designers. The programme will be conducted by the Indian Institute of Gems & Jewellery (IIGJ), Jaipur, from 6th to 23rd July 2026 for beginners and jewellery designers who possess basic knowledge of handcrafted jewellery designing.

Course Title: Computer Aided Designing

Duration: 18 Days (6 Hours per Day)

Mode: On-Campus Training (IIGJ, Jaipur)

The programme includes practical training sessions on Rhinoceros 3D CAD software for developing 3D design assignments. It emphasizes the application of various design techniques that will help participants visualize, evaluate, and optimize the use of materials prior to manufacturing.

The course provides a fast-track foundation in 3D modelling using NURBS techniques. Participants will learn to convert 2D sketches into basic 3D jewellery designs such as rings and pendants. The programme focuses on practical tools, editing techniques, and creating 3D print-ready outputs, thereby building a strong foundation for advanced CAD skills. This comprehensive training experience aims to enhance participants' theoretical knowledge and practical competencies essential for success in the gem and jewellery industry.

Eligibility Criteria

- ✓ Applicants should be below 30 years of age.
- ✓ Applicants who have completed an Advanced Certificate, Diploma, or Degree in Jewellery Designing will not be eligible for this programme.
- ✓ Applicants with more than two years of experience working as Jewellery Designers will not be eligible for this programme.
- ✓ Applicants who do not possess adequate knowledge of the English language will not be eligible for the programme.
- ✓ Applicants who are not mentally and physically fit will not be eligible for the programme.
- ✓ Applicants should possess a valid passport with a minimum validity period of six months.

Due to the limited number of seats available, participants will be selected through a formal interview process. Interested applicants are requested to submit the duly completed standard application form (available at www.ngja.gov.lk) with the words "Capacity Building Training Programme for Sri Lankan Jewellery Designers" clearly indicated on the top left-hand corner of the envelope.
